Day 1. Welcome to Beijing

On arrival, you will be met by local guide. Transfer to Hotel for check in. Rest of the day free at leisure. At 1930 hrs you will be transfer to Indian restaurant for dinner. Transfer back to Hotel. Overnight stay at Hotel.

Day 2. Beijing Tour

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Date: March 18, 2026

As a famous historical and cultural city in China, Beijing exudes the unique charm of a millennium old capital. After breakfast, the guide will wait for you in the hotel lobby. If you want to understand China, **Tian'anmen Square** is a must see. Many significant events occurred here, among which the most important one was the solemn declaration of the founding of the People's Republic of China by Chairman Mao on the Tiananmen Gate Tower on October 1, 1949. Afterwards, walk north along Chang'an Avenue for about 10



minutes to reach the **Forbidden City**, also known as the Palace Museum. This royal palace complex from the Ming and Qing dynasties has nearly 9,000 rooms and was built based on the Nanjing Ming Palace. Your guide is quite knowledgeable and tells you stories about emperors, generals, and ministers that take place in the halls and palaces you visit. 2.5 hours is enough for you to visit the most essence scenic spots in the Forbidden City. Then make a stop at **Jingshan Park**, opposite a street from the Forbidden City. In ancient times, Jingshan Park and its ancillary buildings not only served as a royal garden for visitors but also had multiple functions such as learning shooting, offering sacrifices to ancestors, official learning, opera, and regional activities, etc.

In the afternoon, have a walking tour along the hutongs. You can experience the most authentic Beijing style life in the courtyard with grey walls and tiles. If you want to have an in-depth experience, your guide can take you to a hutong family to try traditional Chinese skills such as tying Chinese knots and paper cuttings (extra fees are required). Have a leisure walk at Shichahai area.

Day 3. Beijing Tour

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Date: March 19, 2026

After hotel breakfast, pay a visit to the elegant **Temple of Heaven**, famous for its meticulous layout, unique architecture and magnificent decoration, this grand complex was built for the emperors of the Ming and Qing dynasties to offer sacrifices to the heaven and pray for good harvests.

In the afternoon, drive for about 2 hours to **Mutianyu Great Wall**. The Great Wall truly is one of the greatest wonders in the world. Today you will visit the Mutianyu Great Wall and see whether it lives up to its reputation. You will definitely be amazed by this military defensive project built by ancient Chinese people.

If you don't have the stamina for a completely hike, you can also pay on your own to take the cable car or a toboggan (recommended for visitors under 60 years old. Children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult). Please be aware that long queues are expected, especially during peak seasons such as Chinese national holidays.(Cost on your own)

Day 4. Beijing- Xian

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Date: March 20, 2026

You will start today's tour with the royal garden in **Summer Palace**. With an area of 2.9 square kilometers, this palace was the best place where the emperors of the Qing Dynasty spent their summers. Here you will enjoy the amazing lake view, explore the exquisite long corridor, appreciate precious cultural relics, step on the elegant stone bridge, see high old trees, etc. You will love every minute here with so much to see. If you are interested, you can experience a Kunming Lake boat ride (with an additional fee on site).

After lunch, the guide will send you to the train station to take the high-speed train to Xi'an, the ancient capital of thirteen dynasties. It takes about 4.5 hours to arrive. The local driver will be waiting at the station to pick you up and transfer you to the hotel in the city center for check-in.

Day 5. Xian Tour

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Date: March 21, 2026

In the morning, you will be met by the local guide and driver at your hotel lobby.

Drive about 40km (about 1 hour) to uncover one of the greatest archaeological discoveries in the world the **Terracotta Army Museum**, which was built by the first emperor of China - Qin Shihuang to protect him in his afterlife. There are about 8,000 vivid life-size Terracotta Warriors found so far. First, pay a visit to the largest and most imposing pit which is believed to contain over 6,000 terracotta figures of soldiers and horses. You will be amazed by the subterranean life-size army of thousands silently standing and guarding the emperor and also be awed by the fabulous artistic skills of ancient Chinese artisans. Next, move to another pit where you can feast your eyes with around 1300 warriors and horses. You can get to examine the ancient army array by visiting the kneeling and standing archers, the chariot war array and numerous troopers holding weapons, etc.

After your visit, head to Big Wild Goose Pagoda Square. Upon arriving at **Big Wild Goose Pagoda Square**, take in the panoramic view of the iconic pagoda in the distance. The square is a hub of activity, surrounded by beautiful greenery and cultural landmarks. You might be fortunate enough to catch the Music Fountain Show on the North Square of Big Wild Goose Pagoda. This spectacular display combines water, light, and music, creating a mesmerizing experience.

In the late afternoon, immerse yourself in the vibrant atmosphere of **Grand Tang Dynasty Ever-bright City**. This cultural and entertainment complex offers a unique blend of history and modernity. As you walk through the city, you'll encounter recreations of Tang Dynasty architecture, bustling markets, and lively street performances. Explore the various attractions, perhaps stopping by traditional tea houses or souvenir shops along the way. The city is designed to transport you back in time, allowing you to experience the rich heritage of the Tang Dynasty. After the leisurely exploration, wind down your day by being escorted back to your hotel.

Day6. Xian Tour

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Date: March 22, 2026

This morning, we are going to drive to **Small Wild Goose Pagoda**, which is a great destination to settle your nerves due to its tranquil and peaceful environment. If you're lucky, you can catch up with such an interesting scene that groups of middle-aged and elderly people are practicing Tai Chi.

Then, you will visit **Xi'an Museum** which is located in the southwest of the Jianfu Temple, Xi'an Museum was opened to the public on the World Museum's Day, May 18th, 2007. It is a three-storied building, with an underground floor unseen from the outside.

After that, visit the **Ancient City Wall** (also known as the Fortification of Xian). The city wall is a kind of defensive structure in Ancient Times and represents one of the oldest, largest, and best-preserved Chinese city walls. Spend some time leisurely walking on the wall and enjoy its inner and outer walls, watchtowers, and moat, and have panoramic views of modern Xian.

In the afternoon, wander through the bustling **Muslim Quarter**, where you can indulge in a variety of street foods and shop for souvenirs. Conclude your day at Bell Tower and Drum Tower Square, where you can appreciate the city's rich heritage and architectural beauty.

Then you will be transferred to Xian airport for your flight to Shanghai. Upon arrival at Shanghai airport, you will be picked up by the local guide and driver, transfer to your hotel. * Please note dinner will be packed food, eat on the flight.

Day7. Shanghai Tour

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Date: March 23, 2026

Start your day by visiting the **Yuyuan Garden**, a 400 years old Chinese-style garden that was built in the Ming Dynasty. The following stop will be the Old City of Shanghai where you will see the old appearance of the city.

After visiting the pretty Yuyuan Garden, you will wander around the lively **Yuyuan Market**. You can get everything here from traditional Chinese crafts like chopsticks, fans, and pottery to local delicacies such as steamed buns, crab shell cake, and pork chop with rice cakes. Don't forget to haggle for a better price. Noon: Lunch in a local restaurant.

Next visit the **Franch concession Xintiandi**, Xintiandi is the top choice in French Concession. It has been a Shanghai icon for over a decade. An upmarket entertainment and shopping complex modelled on traditional alleyway (lòngtáng) homes, this was the first development in the city to prove that historical architecture makes big commercial sense. Elsewhere that might sound like a no-brainer, but in 21st century China, where bulldozers are always on standby, it came as quite a revelation.

Then head to **Nanjing Road**, one of the world's busiest shopping streets. Explore the numerous boutiques, department stores, and specialty shops along this bustling pedestrian street. Don't forget to indulge in some local snacks and street food along the way. Continue your exploration with a visit to **The Bund**, Shanghai's iconic waterfront promenade. Marvel at the stunning skyline of modern skyscrapers on one side, while on the other, you'll find historic buildings that showcase Shanghai's colonial past.

From the Bund, embark on a relaxing **Huangpu River Cruise**. Enjoy panoramic views of Shanghai's skyline and the architectural wonders that line the riverbanks. This cruise will provide a unique perspective on the city's past and present. In the end, you will be sent back to hotel.
