Pompey's Pillar is a Roman triumphal column in Alexandria, Egypt, and the largest of its type constructed outside the imperial capitals of Rome and Constantinople

Visit the Catacombs of Kom el Shoqafa considered as one of the seven Wonders of the Ancient World) (The necropolis consists of a series of Alexandrian tombs, statues and archaeological objects of the Pharaonic funeral cult with Greek and early Roman Influences)

Visit the Alexandria Library

See the 15th century Qaitbay Citadel, built upon the ruins of the ancient Alexandria Lighthouse from the outside - this defensive fortress is located on the Mediterranean sea coast.
