DAY ZERO ASSEMBLE TO LEAVE KOLKATA / DELHI

Welcome to the world of Around The World, having goodwill of more than 15 years serving the corporate world & leisure traveller. Your experienced and pleasant Tour Coordinator from our company, who will accompany you throughout the tour, will meet & greet you at Kolkata Netaji Subhas International Airport 2 hours before the departure time. She / He will assist you for immigration & custom formalities before boarding the flight. You will need to book



your luggage till Copenhagen as early as you reach New Delhi Airport T3. Meal will be served on the flight.

DAY ONE COPENHAGEN

After arrival at Airport you will be meet. Greet and transfer to our Hotel with local



and transfer to our Hotel with local representative. Check in at Hotel and rest till dinner. At 1900 hrs you will be picked up from Hotel and transfer to Indian restaurant for Dinner. Later drop to your hotel for overnight stay at hotel. You can enjoy nightlife in Copenhagen.

DAY TWO COPENHAGEN CITY TOUR

Breakfast at Hotel. After breakfast leave by coach with local English speaking Guide to explore the city – Copenhagen. Sights of interest that we will cover are the must-see Little Mermaid, Old Port of Nyhavn, the Gefion Fountain, Royal Palace of Amalienborg and Rosenborg Castle from outside. The Rosenborg Castle Garden, called



'King's Garden' is the oldest royal garden of Denmark. We'll get a chance to walk down at the 'Stroget' – one of the largest pedestrian shopping streets in the world. Later we'll visit to the magic land – Tivoli Garden which is the major attraction of the city and also known as the Tivoli



Amusement Park. Established in 1843, it is a beautiful & romantic park with lanterns in the trees that create a unique atmosphere with the backdrop sound of traditional folk music. Copenhagen once a humble fishing village is now the glittering capital of Danish Empire. The city is considered to be one of the world's premier capitals of Design and Scandinavia's pre-eminent city. The sumptuous palaces, copper roofed town and charming cobbled squares will show you why it's called the Capital of Design. Also visit Christiansburg Palace. Dinner at Indian restaurant. Overnight stay at Hotel.

DAY THREE COPENHAGEN TO OSLO, STAY AT CRUISE

After breakfast, check out from hotel and join a marvellous Grand Canal Cruise tour. It is guided tour starting from Ved Stranden / Nyhavn and it continues One hours to One hour 30 minutes and cover almost all city attraction of Denmark. Later board in to Cruise for Oslo. Dinner and overnight stay at Cruise.

DAY FOUR OSLO CITY TOUR

Pick up from Oslo Port and we drive down to explore the capital of Norway, Oslo. The Norwegian



English speaking Guide will welcome you and take you for a City Tour by coach. Oslo – the Capital of Norway is situated at the head of the Oslo Fjord surrounded by the forested ridges. Thus this location gives Oslo unexpected quality for a national capital and a widely varied

cultural life. During the city tour you will see a selection of sights...like a visit to the Vigeland Sculpture Park with the lifetime work of the sculptor maestro Gustav Vigeland. The Vigeland Park is the world's largest sculpture park made by a single artist, and is one of Norway's most popular tourist attractions. The park is open to visitors all year round. The unique sculpture park is Gustav Vigeland's lifework with more than 200 sculptures in bronze, granite and wrought iron. Vigeland was also in charge of the design and architectural layout of the park. The Vigeland Park was mainly completed between 1939 and 1949. Most of the sculptures are placed in five units along an 850 meter long axis: The Main gate, the Bridge with the Children's playground, the Fountain, the Monolith plateau and the Wheel of Life. We'll have an orientation tour with sights such as the Royal Palace, Holmenkollen Ski-Jump and the Oslo Harbor. Also visit Bygdoy museum Island. Dinner at Indian restaurant overnight stay at Oslo.

DAY FIVE OSLO-STCKHOLM BY FLIGHT. STAY AT STOCKHOLM

AROUND THE WORLD

After breakfast check out from hotel and proceed to Airport to board flight to Stockholm. Arrive Stockholm and transfer to Hotel. Afternoon enjoy city night life. Dinner and overnight stay at Stockholm.

DAY SIX CITY TOUR AT STOCKHOLM & LATER FLY TO HELSINKI

After breakfast check out from hotel and start City tour of Stockholm. The local guide will welcome you and take you on a City Tour by coach. During the city tour you will see the main



attractions of this Swedish capital, such as The Royal Theatre, Stockholm Cathedral and of course The Gamla Stan. The town dates back to the 13th century, and consists of medieval alleyways, cobbled streets, and archaic architecture. North German architecture has had a strong influence in the Old Town's construction. Stroget is the name of the scenic large square in the centre of Gamla Stan. As well as being home to the Stockholm the Nobel Cathedral, Museum, and the Riddarholm church, Gamla Stan also

boasts Kungliga slottet, Sweden's baroque Royal Palace, built in the 18th century. Afternoon is yours...walk around and soak in the sights and sounds of Stockholm which offers many interesting cafes and has become an el dorado for shoppers. Discover the small shops in Sodermalm – the bohemian district. You can buy tickets for an excursion of different boats and canals in Stockholm. Thereafter drop to airport to fly Helsinki. Arrive Helsinki and after Indian dinner drop to Hotel. Overnight stay at Helsinki.

DAY SEVEN | CITY TOUR AT HELSINKI

Welcome to Finland, the last country of our Scandinavia tour program. After breakfast we begin with a city tour of the Finnish Capital, Helsinki. Our local English speaking Guide will first give you the taste of Helsinki with some exclusive photo stops. Helsinki is so compact & beautiful that it's ideal to explore the city on foot. We'll also cover some places of the sightseeing of this important city of design, architecture & galleries on foot. The Senate Square and its surroundings form a unique and cohesive example of Neo Classical architecture. The square is dominated by four buildings designed by Carl Ludvig Engel between 1822 and 1852.

We'll now visit The Cathedral of Helsinki which is a must and is perhaps the most photographed area & recognizable building in Finland. It's an Evangelical Lutheran Cathedral and the seat of the Diocese of Helsinki. It used to be known as St Nicholas' Church till the independence in 1917.Next, we visit the Sibelius Monument at the Sibelius Park, which is the world famous composer Jean Sibelius'(1865–1957) monument by Eila Hiltunen. It was unveiled on 7.9.1967.

AROUND THE WORLD

The Sibelius Monument resembles organ pipes, is made of welded steel with the bust of the composer on one side. Dinner at Indian restaurant. Overnight stay at Helsinki.

DAY EIGHT HELSINKI TO KIRUNA BY FLIGHT. STAY AT KIRUNA

After breakfast check out from Helsinki hotel and transfer to Airport to board flight to Kiruna . Kiruna is a town in the far north of Swedish Lapland. It's known for the huge LKAB iron ore mine and its underground visitors center with an exhibit on mining. Hjalmar Lundbohmsgården, the 19th-century former home of LKAB's first managing director, is now a museum with a courtyard photography exhibit. Kiruna Church is notable for its bell tower and resemblance to the traditional huts of the indigenous Sámi people. We will visit Ice Hotel here and will chase for Northern light by Bus. Kiruna situated 67.8558° N, 20.2253° Latitude that means within Arctic Circle. Dinner at Indian restaurant, Overnight stay at Kiruna, Sweden.

DAY NINE KIRUNA TO TROMSO-TRAVEL 67.8558° N TO 69.6° N LATITUDE

After breakfast at Kiruna hotel, check out and proceed to Tromso, situated in northern Norway.



Total 390 Kilometer will be cover in 6 hours. The road goes through another North Norway city Narvik. The road is very much picturesque, you may see Northern lights on the way to the entire road journey. Arrive Tromso and check in to hotel. Dinner at Indian restaurant, overnight stay at Hotel. Tromsø is a city in Tromsø Municipality in Troms county, Norway. The city is the administrative centre of the municipality as well as

the administrative centre of Troms county. The Diocese of Nord–Hålogaland and its Bishop are based at the Tromsø Cathedral in the city.

DAY TEN AT TROMSO, CITY TOUR

After breakfast proceed for a marvellous city tour at Tromso, covering, Fjellheisen cable car ride, Arctic Cathedral, Dog and Render Sledging (Optional) and also chasing Northern light tour by boat. Dinner and overnight stay at Tromso, Norway.

DAY ELEVEN TROMSO TO OSLO BY FLIGHT

After breakfast checkout from hotel and proceed to Airport to board flight to Oslo. Arrive Oslo Airport and drop to Hotel. Exlore the city on your own. You may opt for shopping tour





or relax at hotel. Dinner and overnight stay at Oslo Hotel.

DAY TWELVE | RETURN FLIGHT

After breakfast drop to Airport for return flight to Kolkata / Delhi/ Mumbai.
